Visit one or more viewing stations during the festival and observe the birds you see there. For help identifying birds, check out the simple I.D. guide on the back of your bingo sheets. Complete a row (down, across, or diagonal) on a bingo sheet for that particular viewing station and have it count as one of your requirements for your Jr. Birder notebook.
